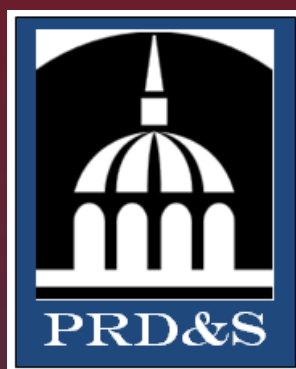

With the addition of Senator Steve Symms (Idaho) to the team, we became known as Parry, Romani, DeConcini & Symms (PRD&S). Today, PRD&S is one of the most successful and effective firms in the crowded field of Washington legislative advocacy.

From our very first clients, the Motion Picture Association of America and Sony, PRD&S has attracted many of the most prestigious corporations active in Washington. STEVE SYMMS
United States Senator (Retired)
Member, U.S. House (Retired)

The Honorable Steve Symms, former United States Senator from Idaho, was born in Nampa, Idaho, on April 23, 1938. A graduate of Caldwell High School, Senator Symms earned a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Idaho. After serving three years in the United States Marine Corps, he returned to the Symms Fruit Ranch, Inc., his family business in Caldwell, Idaho.

A political unknown in 1972, he ran for and won a seat in the United States House of Representatives. In 1980 Congressman Symms won election to the Senate upsetting a long-term incumbent and was re-elected in 1986, defeating a 10-year sitting governor.

Before his January, 1993 retirement from the US Senate, Senator Symms served on the Finance and Armed Services Committees, and was also a member of the Environment and Public Works Committee. He Chaired the Transportation Subcommittee and managed several highway bills.

During his years of public service, Senator Symms was selected to receive the US Marine Corps “Iron Mike” award and the National Guard’s “Minuteman of the Year” award, in addition to awards from such groups as the National Federation of Independent Business, the Freedom Foundation, the American Security Council, the Watchdog of the Treasury, Americans for Constitutional Action and the U.S. Chamber of Commerce.

Upon his retirement, Senator Symms formed his own consulting firm. In 2001, he joined forces with Parry, Romani & DeConcini to form Parry, Romani, DeConcini & Symms.

Senator Symms formerly served on a number of Boards, including the PanAmerica Capital Group, Bellhaven Copper & Gold, Inc., Albertsons, Inc., Symms Fruit Ranch, Freedom Alliance and American Conservative Union.

Senator Symms and his wife, Loretta, reside in Northern Virginia.

JAMES W. ROCK

James W. Rock joined the firm in February 2002. He has represented both trade groups and individual compounding pharmacies for over 12 years, and has been involved in both legislative and regulatory efforts during that time period. His clients include pharmacies that provide necessary compounded medications to patients and providers throughout the U.S., including both human and animal drugs.

Mr. Rock has over 25 years of experience in the private sector representing clients on both legislative and regulatory matters. He brings considerable expertise in the area of taxation, including real estate, utility taxation, estate and gift taxation, employee benefits, accounting, international taxation, oil and gas, tax-exempt organizations, minimum tax, insurance, tax-exempt bonds, and small business. He has also provided legislative representation to his clients on other issues, including the regulation of medical devices by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), Medicare, education, health, utility deregulation, appropriations, budget, commerce, energy, telecommunications, internet commerce and judiciary matters.

THADDEUS E. STROM
Vice President, Congressional Relations

Thaddeus Strom joined Parry, Romani, DeConcini & Symms in February 2004 as Vice President for Congressional Relations after more than two decades of service on Capitol Hill. Mr. Strom also represented Senator Thurmond at weekly Republican leadership staff meetings in the Majority Leader's office to discuss implementation of the Republican agenda in the US Senate.

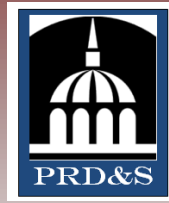
From 1991 to 1993, while Senator Thurmond was Ranking Member and Senior Republican on the Senate Judiciary Committee, Mr. Strom served as the Chief Counsel and Staff Director to the Republican members. In this capacity, he was the chief strategist and legislative advisor to the Republicans on all legislation referred to the committee. Also, Mr. Strom was responsible for the organization and direction of Republican staff members on the Committee.

From 1988 to 1991, Mr. Strom served as General Counsel to Republicans on the Senate Judiciary Committee, providing substantive analysis and devising strategy on bills referred to the Committee.

Mr. Strom served as Chief of Staff to Senator Strom Thurmond from 1986 to 1988. As Chief of Staff, Mr. Strom was responsible for formulating and directing office policy for Senator Thurmond in all areas of his US Senate office. Mr. Strom received a bachelor's degree in Political Science from Clemson University, and his Juris Doctor from the University of South Carolina School of Law. He and his family reside in the District of Columbia.

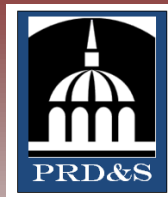
